

Metal clip for cotton wool

Technical sheet

Description:

The metal clip for cotton wool is a metal piece made of thin galvanized sheet metal, profiled and cold stamped with a self-adhesive base.

Features:

Material	ordinary carbon steel
Thickness	0.5 mm
size	50 x 50 mm

Areas of use:

Fixing and stabilizing the glass or basalt wool in plasterboard walls or on a supporting support.

Metal staples for cotton wool must be used in accordance with the design and recommendations of the manufacturer of plasterboard materials and systems.

Recommendations:

The metal staples are fixed inside the plasterboard systems, by gluing and mechanical fixing with 6x40 dowels on brick or concrete supports and with AF 212x25 screws so that they do not exceed the thickness of the plasterboard plates.

If NIDA systems are made with a double metal structure, and on each metal structure the installation of mineral or basaltic wool is specified,

the fixing of clips in the system is carried out on previously mounted plasterboard strips, on the inside face of the metal structure.

Protective measures:

Metal clips for cotton wool are not classified in the category of hazardous products. When installing metal clips in plasterboard boards, it is recommended that the fitter use a mask, gloves and goggles.
